i. Beatty Chamber

Ann Marchand – Stated that the Chamber has applied for some NCOT (Nevada Commission of Tourism) grants this fiscal year, for the first cycle of this year, and were awarded three grants; the first being the Multilanguage brochures for \$5,000.00, the second is a certified rack holder display which is a company that fills brochure racks in motels, parks, visitor centers and so forth in different areas. We have targeted areas in California, Mammoth and Las Vegas for \$3608.00, the third is for Nevada Magazine January through June cycle for \$3,000.00. All of the grants are matching fund grants and we anticipate having enough in our advertising account, if we don't we will let you know. The certified rack display was a grant we turned back last year because we didn't feel like we had the matching funds for the grant. EG – Stated the letter is not complete and I was kind of worried because the comment period ended January 7th but it has been extended to January 21st so there is still time to write it. In the meantime I watched the whole meeting that Darrell and Levi held in Pahrump on December 1st, and I reviewed the backup documentation. What I thought we could do is write a letter saying we object to this and we don't want you to do anything else in these areas; big dune, bare mountain, ash meadows, things that they are putting new ACEC's on, we can't do it like that. You have to be very specific, you have to state the area, the size, what it is that's listed, and what your comment is on that. The Library has the actual document. I am focusing on our area only. I would like to table this until the first meeting in January.

Carrie Radomski; Town Secretary – Stated Chief Harmon is on an Ambulance run and apologizes that he cannot be here, and asked that Kelly Carroll answer questions about this item.

KC – Stated that this is an annual test that has to be done, Vance says that it is not within his budget to do this testing but it is within our (BVFD) budget, so we ask that the Town Board approve, using the Fire Departments budget, getting these tests done; Discussion followed.

Ms. Radomski - Stated there is only one quote which is allowable because this is a specialty item.

Carrie Radomski; Town Secretary – Stated that Vance Payne, Nye County Emergency Services Director has looked at the inventory of tires on our vehicles and it is ageing, replacement is something we need to do. The Fire Department is coming to the Board for funding which can be taken from their (BVFD) operating or possibly their capital accounts if the four tires could be considered as one capital purchase. There are two quotes in your packets, one from Purcell out of Pahrump for \$3,974.79 and one from Revert 24 Hour Tire in Beatty \$3,826.76; Discussion followed.

EG – Stated that this, like the ladder testing, was covered by the County in the past but with all of their budget issues we can expect more expenses; Discussion followed.
