

I am pleased to announce that we are expanding our [my Social Security](#) online wage reporting service to Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients, as well as their spouses, parents, sponsors, and representative payees. Individuals receiving both Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and SSI, as well as their representative payees, can also report wages online. This service is available through our existing [my Social Security](#) portal. *Note: SSI recipients, their spouses, parents, sponsors, and representative payees may still use the SSI Mobile Wage Reporting and SSI Telephone Wage Reporting applications. However, the preferred wage reporting method for individuals receiving both SSDI and SSI is the [my Social Security](#) online wage reporting service.*
