**WATER/WASTEWATER MAINTENANCE WORKER I**

Under general supervision, performs a combination of technical, semi-skilled tasks, manual labor, and operate equipment to support the construction, maintenance and repair of lift stations, water and wastewater infrastructure. Applicant must have a high school diploma or GED, valid Class C Nevada driver's license and respond to the public and others in a courteous and respectful manner. In addition, must achieve a T-1, D-2, and Wastewater 1 certification within one year of hire.

The physical requirements described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of the job. Strenuous physical work including lifting and loading of heavy objects (up to 100 pounds), digging, shoveling, raking, physically demanding work for continuous and lengthy periods of time, often combine with bending, twisting, squatting, reaching, and working on irregular surfaces; strength, dexterity, and stamina to stand for long periods and to perform manual tasks using heavy hand and power tools.

Most work is performed outside with exposure to extreme weather conditions including heat, rain, snow, cold, and wind. Frequent exposure to noise, dust, fumes, and odors. Potential exposure to toxic chemicals and solvents, such as, herbicides and/or confined areas. These exposures require the use of safety equipment and procedures. Work may be performed independently and may be in isolated geographic areas. Mandatory overtime may be required in urgent or emergency situations for the purpose of maintaining staff on weekends and holidays.

Salary range of \$14 to \$17 depending on qualifications. Excellent benefit package (100% paid PERS – State Retirement is not covered by Social Security.) Health insurance is provided to the employee by the District. This is an “at will employment”, non-exempt position with pre-employment screening required. The Beatty Water & Sanitation is a drug free workplace and an equal opportunity provider.
