However, should item(s) not be completed, it is possible item(s) could be carried over and be heard before the BGID Board beginning at 8:30 a.m. on the next day.

Public Comment during the BGID Board Meeting on September 25, 2020 will be for all matters, both on and off the agenda, and be limited to three minutes per person. Additionally, public comment of three minutes per person will be heard during individual action items. The BGID Board reserves the right to reduce the time or limit the total time allowed for public comment. The BGID Board may prohibit comment if the content of the comments is a topic that is not relevant to, or within the authority of, the BGID Board, or if the content of the comments is willfully disruptive of the meeting by being irrelevant, repetitious, slanderous, offensive, inflammatory, irrational or amounting to personal attacks or interfering with the rights of other speakers. Persons are invited to submit comments in writing on the agenda items and/or attend and make comment on that item at the BGID Board meeting.
