## **Nevada Early Intervention Services**

Because all babies are different, they rarely do the same thing at exactly the same age. As a result, it's not unusual for families to have questions or concerns about their child's development. They may wonder; Why isn't my son sitting up? Why isn't my daughter crawling? Why doesn't my son talk like other children his age?



Nevada Early Intervention Services' programs provide community-based services, such as speech therapy, physical therapy, among others, for all Nevada's infants and toddlers (eligible for Early Intervention services), and their families. Early intervention focuses on helping eligible babies and toddlers learn the basic and brand-new skills that typically develop during the first three years of life.

If parents are concerned about their child's development, the first step is to have their child referred for evaluation, which looks at his or her basic skills. **There is no cost!** Parents or family members can refer the child directly or they can have a child's physician or another professional make the referral for them.
